- Recommended Semester Credit Conversion - Conversion of length of course into college units; 10 clock hours of classroom learning is equivalent to 0.5 semester credits; 15 clock hours of clinical/lab learning is equivalent to 0.5 semester credits; NOTE: Only the college level component of each course is converted to college credit. The non-academic portion is not converted.
- Combinable - In order to maximize University credit earning potential, similar courses less than 10 clock hours in length may be combined. Combinations of courses equivalent to 10 clock hours of academic merit will earn 0.5 semester credits.
- University of Phoenix Equivalency - General Education or Elective Category where credit of course can be applied.
- Non-academic - Lack of college level theory and/or principle necessary for credit recognition
